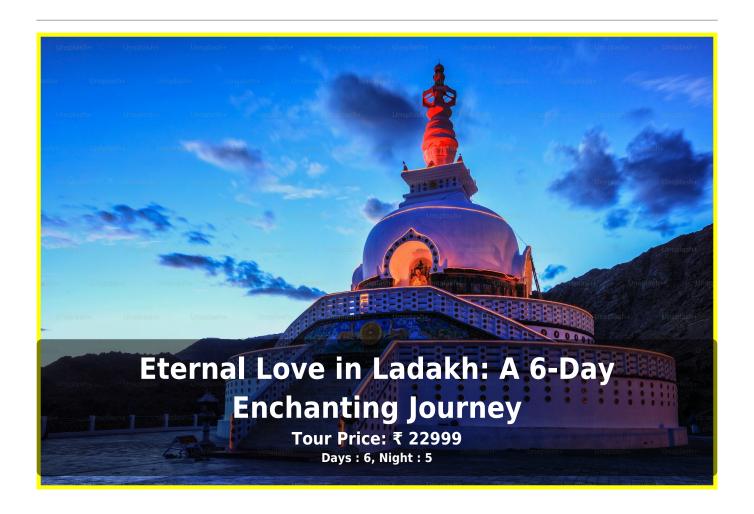

ITINERARIES:

Day 1: Arrival in Leh

Upon arrival at Leh airport, you'll be greeted and transferred to your hotel. Check-in to the hotel and enjoy welcome tea/coffee. Take the day to rest and acclimatize to the high altitude. Later in the day, explore Leh Market, Leh Palace, Hall of Fame, and the Shanti Stupa at your own pace. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel in Leh. Inclusions: Accommodation & Dinner

Day 2: Leh City Tour with Sham Valley

Breakfast at the hotel. Embark on a day tour covering the local sights of Leh and Sham Valley. Highlights: Leh Palace, Shanti Stupa, Magnetic Hill, Sangam Point (where the Indus and Zanskar rivers meet), Gurudwara Pathar Sahib, Hall of Fame Museum, and Local Market. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel in Leh. Inclusions: Accommodation, Breakfast & Dinner

Day 3: Leh to Nubra Valley

Breakfast at the hotel. Check out and drive to Nubra Valley via Khardung La Pass, the highest motorable road in the world (18,380 ft). Arrive at Diskit in the afternoon and check into the hotel. Visit Diskit Monastery, one of the largest and oldest monasteries in Nubra Valley. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel in Nubra. Inclusions: Accommodation, Breakfast & Dinner

Day 4: Nubra Valley to Pangong Lake

Breakfast at the hotel. Check out and proceed to Pangong Lake. Known for its changing hues, Pangong is one of Ladakh's most famous and scenic lakes. Arrive at the campsite near Pangong Lake and check in. Spend the evening by the lake, enjoying the beautiful surroundings. Dinner and overnight stay in a camp near Pangong. Inclusions: Accommodation, Breakfast & Dinner

Day 5: Pangong Lake to Leh (Via Hemis, Thiksey, and Shey)

Breakfast at the camp. Check out and return to Leh. Enroute visits to Hemis Monastery, Thiksey Monastery, and Shey Palace. Arrive in Leh and check into your hotel. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel in Leh. Inclusions: Accommodation, Breakfast & Dinner

Day 6: Departure from Leh

Breakfast at the hotel. Check out and transfer to Leh Airport for your onward journey, taking with you unforgettable memories of Ladakh. Inclusions: Breakfast Only

FAOS:

Q: What is the best time to visit Ladakh for this tour?

A: The best time to visit is from May to September when the weather is most favorable, with clear skies and accessible roads.

A: You will stay in comfortable hotels in Leh and Nubra Valley, and cozy camps near Pangong Lake. Each accommodation offers basic amenities suitable for high-altitude travel.

Q: Is this tour suitable for elderly travelers or children?

A: The tour can be enjoyed by all age groups, but travelers with pre-existing medical conditions should consult a doctor before visiting high-altitude areas.
