

This 4-day Kinnaur trip from Shimla offers a stunning Himalayan experience. Start with a scenic drive from Shimla to Sangla (2 nights), passing through Kufri, Narkanda, and along the Sutlej River. In Sangla, explore Kamru Fort and visit Chitkul, the last Indian village before Tibet, known for its riverside charm and mountain views. Then, travel to Kalpa (1 night), famous for breathtaking views of the Kinnaur Kailash range, Roghi village's cliffside "Suicide Point," and the serene Narayan-Nagini Temple. After enjoying these scenic landscapes and vibrant local culture, return to Shimla, completing a memorable Kinnaur adventure.

ITINERARIES:

• Day 1: Day 1: Shimla to Sangla

Distance: Approximately 220 km Travel Time: 8-9 hours Itinerary: Early Morning: Start your journey from Shimla and head towards Sangla Valley, taking in the scenic views along the way. En Route: Stop at Kufri, Narkanda (famous for apple orchards and the Hatu Peak), and Rampur Bushahr for breaks, snacks, and sightseeing. Afternoon: Continue the journey along the Sutlej River, which offers breathtaking views of the valley and cliffs. Arrival at Sangla: Check into your hotel or guesthouse in Sangla by late afternoon/evening. Evening: Relax after the long drive, explore the small village, or take a stroll by the Baspa River. Overnight: Sangla

• Day 2: Day 2: Explore Sangla Valley and Chitkul

Distance (Sangla to Chitkul): 23 km (about 1-1.5 hours) Itinerary: Morning: Have breakfast, then set out to explore Sangla Valley. Visit Kamru Fort: This fort near Sangla offers panoramic views and has a temple dedicated to the local deity Kamakhya Devi. Excursion to Chitkul: Drive to Chitkul, the last inhabited village on the Indo-Tibetan border. Walk through the quaint village, enjoy the scenic surroundings, and take photos of the majestic Kinnaur Kailash range. Picnic by the Baspa River: Chitkul has beautiful riverside spots where you can have a peaceful lunch or snack. Return to Sangla: Head back to Sangla by evening and relax. Overnight: Sangla

Day 3: Day 3: Sangla to Kalpa

Distance: Approximately 40 km Travel Time: 2-3 hours Itinerary: Morning: Have breakfast, then depart for Kalpa, another picturesque town known for its apple orchards and stunning views of the Kinnaur Kailash range. Arrival in Kalpa: Check into your hotel and freshen up. Explore Kalpa: Roghi Village: Known for its stunning views of Kinnaur Kailash, traditional houses, and famous "suicide point" cliffs. Suicide Point: A popular viewpoint for daring photos but always ensure safety while visiting. Kalpa Monastery and Narayan-Nagini Temple: Learn about the local culture and traditions at these spiritual spots. Evening: Enjoy the sunset over the Kinnaur Kailash range. The view of the mountains turning golden at dusk is a highlight. Overnight: Kalpa

• Day 4: Day 4: Kalpa to Shimla

Distance: Approximately 220 km Travel Time: 8-9 hours Itinerary: Morning: Have an early breakfast and start your return journey to Shimla. En Route: Take breaks at scenic spots, and enjoy the beautiful landscapes. Afternoon/Evening: Arrive back in Shimla by evening, marking the end of your Kinnaur adventure.
